- Be the face of the camp and provide excellent customer service and troubleshooting throughout the booking, camping, and retention process.
- Maintain client communication and rapport by greeting families at drop off and pick up, as well as communicate via phone or email as required.

- Ensuring weekly paperwork is complete for the City of Richmond Hill and for campers (camp certificates, evaluations, lesson program information, etc).
